You can book a one night stay during weekdays (Sunday - Thursday), a two night minimum during weekends (Friday - Saturday) and for long weekends, we require a three night commitment.

Note: You cannot check-in or check-out on a Saturday.

Accommodations

Our cottages offer approximately 500 sq. ft. of indoor living space and sleep up to a family of 6 – 2 adults and 4 children (under the age of 16). They are fully equipped with a kitchen (full size fridge & stove, microwave, coffee maker and toaster), bathroom, 2 or 3 bedrooms, heating\air conditioning, TV with DVD player (**NO** cable or WIFI so bring DVDs!), and a full-size deck with a BBQ with propane, fire pit and patio set.

What You Should Bring

– 1 Queen, 1 twin, 2 doubles*
- Beach towels
- Bathroom towels & face cloths
- Napkins
- Dish soap
- Dish towel and cloth
- Toiletries
- Bug spray
- Water shoes

- Folding chairs for around fire pit

Note: Bed sizes are based on 2-bedroom cottage. Please ask one of our Resort Specialists to confirm your bed sizes as they vary by accommodation.

Sanitary System

We are on a private septic system, the following guidelines are to be followed:

- ONLY one-ply toilet tissue may be flushed; baby wipes, diapers, hygiene products, paper and any other disposable items must be placed in garbage bags and disposed of with regular waste.
- Household liquids or chemicals must not be flushed or put down the sinks including fats, oil and grease, coffee grounds, solid food waste or bleach.

Smoking

For your health and enjoyment, all accommodations are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted outside the accommodation and in designated areas only. (Please refer to Resort & Reservations Policies for more information)

Pool Hours of Operation

May 15th- September 29th *

Hours during "Off-Peak": 9am – 6pm

Hours during "Peak": 8am – 8pm

Pools may close during rain, thunderstorms and for emergency maintenance.

To ensure the inclusion of everyone wishing to use our pool facilities, we request swimmers wear swimsuit and/or clean clothing (wear non-cotton t-shirts, thin long sleeve shirts, shorts or leggings) brought to the facility for the purpose of swimming. Participants using the pool must change from street clothes. Undergarments, cut-offs and jeans are not permitted in the pool.

Note: Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Please be aware most of our pools and beach areas do not have lifeguards.

Our goal is to have all pools open by May 15th, weather permitting and is subject to change.

Parking

Each recreational cottage has parking for one vehicle. Limited overflow parking is available for one extra vehicle per reservation and is subject to a parking fee of \$25 + HST per day. Please check in at the Welcome Centre for payment and receipt of the parking tag. Any unregistered vehicle will be towed at owner's expense.

Resort Speed Limit

Obey speed limit signs posted at the resort.

Housekeeping

Housekeeping service is not provided during your stay. Housekeeping is completed after your check-out. If additional housekeeping is required above and beyond the normal time allotted for each accommodation, the credit card used for the security deposit will be charged. (Please see Resort & Reservations Policy for more information).

Noise

Quiet Time is from 11:00pm through 8:00am. Please respect the quiet enjoyment of your neighbours! (Please refer to Resort & Reservation Policies for more information.)

Pets

We are a pet friendly resort. Please ensure your pet is always on a leash. While pets can swim along some shoreline areas away from the beach, they are not permitted on the beach, in the playground, pool, marina or interior public building areas. Pet owners are required to "stoop and scoop". Pets showing signs of aggression or causing on-going disturbances to others will be asked to leave the resort.

Alcohol

Alcohol consumption is allowed on property but must be contained in a non-glass container for safety purposes.

Boats, Trailers & Dock Slips

There are a limited number of dock slips available for rent at a rate of \$25.00 per day. Please check with the resort directly for availability.

First Aid Station

A First Aid Station is located in the Welcome Centre and pool areas. Our General Managers and several key resort team members are First Aid and CPR trained. Please report an accident, injury or safety concern immediately to our Welcome Centre.

Garbage

Garbage is to be taken to the designated waste areas. Ask at the Welcome Centre where the garbage is located at your resort.

Day Passes for Rental Guests

Guests are permitted to have guests join you for the day. Day passes may be purchased from the Welcome Centre for payment and wristbands for your guests. Adult day pass \$35.00, Kids 6-16 \$25.00, Kids 5 and under free.
